He called for Triangles a few summers ago when Toby was out of town. Toby will be calling at the Anniversary Dance as well. It should be exciting to hear what they can do together! Jack von Der Heide will be the guest cuer for the round dances.

Swingtime Center is quite a drive for some of you, but it is a very popular place for DFW area dancers which should mean many guests.

- We can get in the building at 6:00 and the dance begins at 7:00. We will need to hit the floor running. Decorations will be kept to a minimum but we will need help getting set up. PLEASE be there at 6:00 pm to get ready. The tables and chairs will be set up, but we will need to set up food tables as well as drinks. This is definitely one of those "it takes a village" times.
- The club voted to do soup, chili, cornbread and desserts. Please sign up on the survey provided or at lessons or a dance to let co-chairs Kathy Haule and Donna Miller know what you will bring. The club will provide paper goods/drinks.

- Our Anniversary Dance is a "double signature" dance for dancers who participated in Friendship Fun as explained on the Nortex website. Dancers can receive two signatures rather than one on their Silver or Gold card which means they take a bigger step towards getting a badge dangle.
