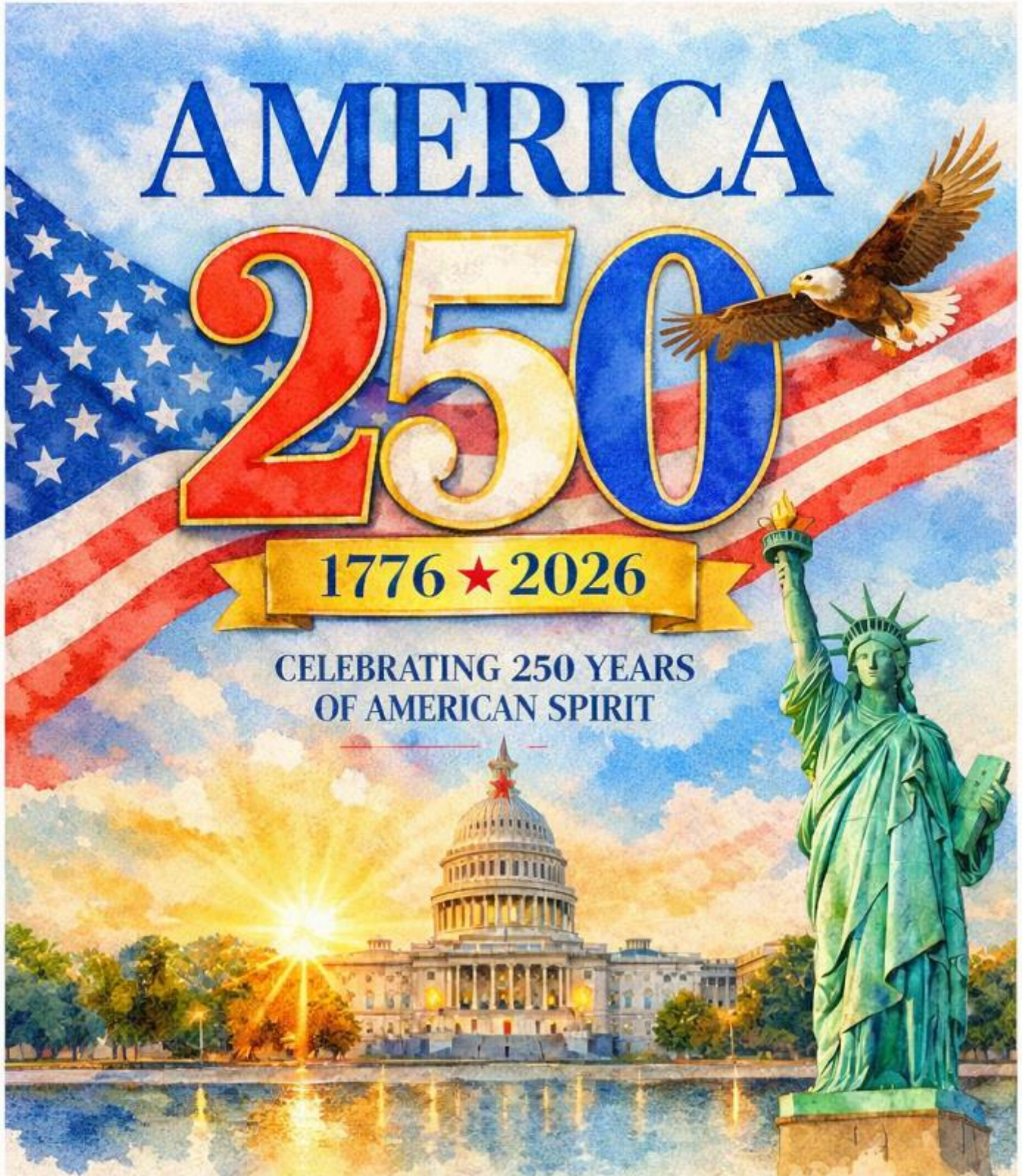

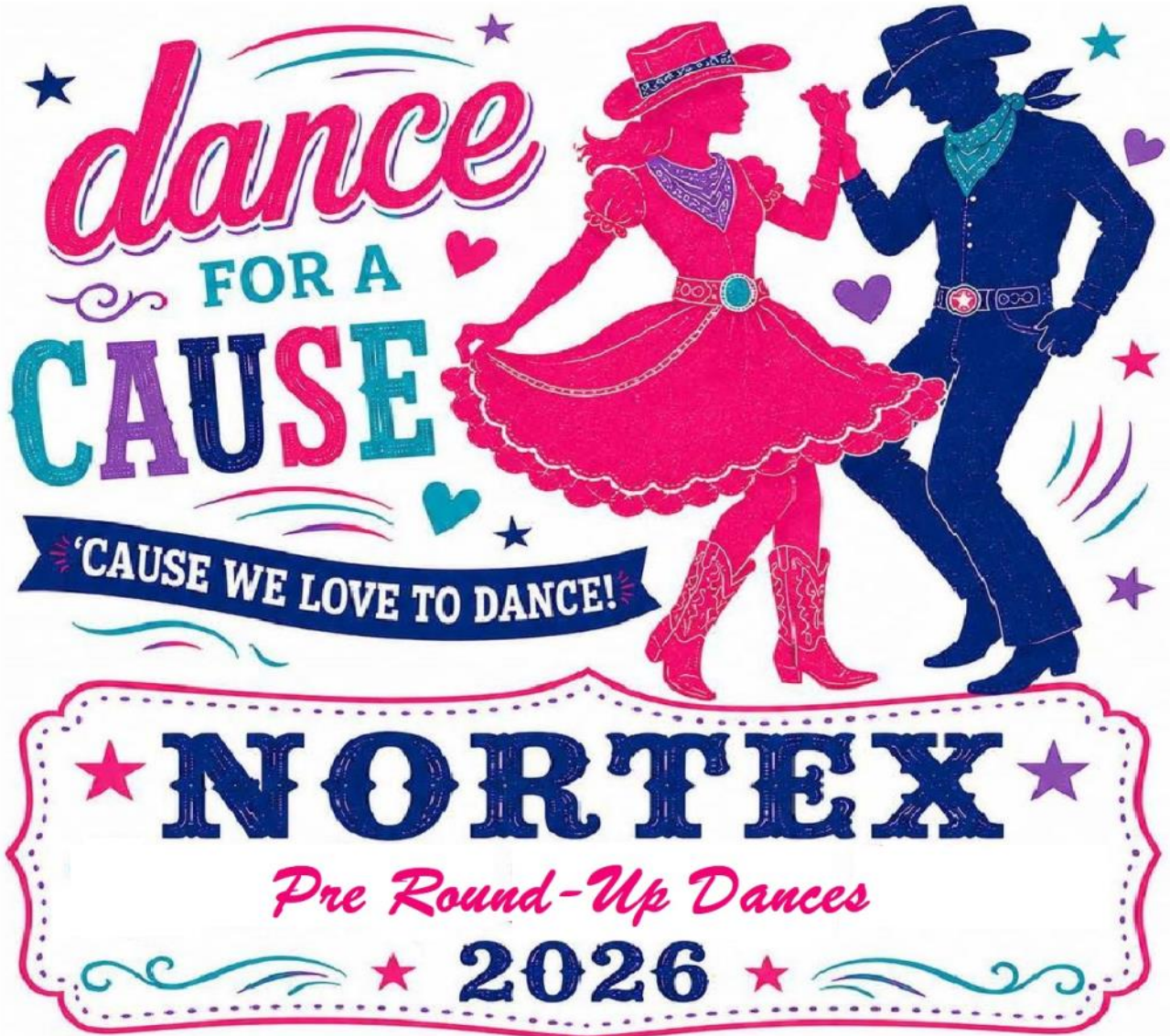

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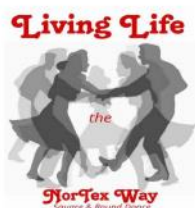

Tri-City Promenaders – Club of the Year This club was formed on August 9, 1960. The grand opening dance was in September with 20 squares in attendance dancing to a live band. They had many guest callers including Melton Luttrell and Jon Jones. The club danced on second and fourth Tuesdays. There is a long history of officers who donated their time and energy to NORTEX in a variety of positions and projects. Some club tidbits include them hosting the 4th NORTEX Round-Up in 1964, Jon Jones was their caller from March 1963 until November 1966, in 1983 the club moved their dances to 2nd and 4th Saturdays, now they only dance on 4th Saturdays. They were last awarded Club of the Year in 2023. There are 22 pages of history and pictures showing their great journey from “Then until Now” in the Promenade. They have received a Growth Achievement Award 3 out of the last 4 years. Their dances are always fun with a variety of themes. Their Club Caller, Ray Savell, always accommodates the theme with his attire and choice of music.



Karen McGinney and Richard Koch - Dancer of the Year She belonged to a Teen Square Dance Club. During her college years, she danced with the Kilgore College Rangerettes. She has been Circle I Treasurer since 2023 and is also Treasurer for Rainbow Rounds. She has served NORTEX as an Area Vice-President, Treasurer and Director. She and her late husband were presidents for Levis and Lace and later became members of Circle I. She loves square dance, round dance and country western dance. He is a natural on the dance floor. Square dancing was introduced to him in his 20's. He influenced many people to learn to square dance. He and his family ventured out weekly dancing with Branches and Twigs Square Dance Club in Farmers Branch. They have been dance partners square dancing and round dancing since 2023. They can be found visiting across the region. It is a joy to watch them dance.



Dan & Ruanne Banse - Rookie of the Year These dancers initially heard about square dancing while living in Alabama. They did not take lessons until they moved to Texas and found the Tri-City Promenaders having lessons. They finished these lessons and took lessons again later with the Roadrunners to perfect their skills. After completing lessons in both locations, they joined both clubs. After completing lessons, they fell in love with dancing, the people and the JOY it brings into their lives. They have shared their joy with their friends and are trying to recruit others into square dancing. They started plus lessons the same year they learned mainstream and have never looked back. They quickly moved into NORTEX and have been voted in as area VP's this year.

Karen and Peter Chambers - Teen Rookie of the Year These dancers took lessons with the Roadrunners with Toby and Mike. After completion of mainstream lessons, one of them began studying taminations and definitions of plus moves. This led to this dancer successfully learning plus totally on his own.

The other dancer started a square dance club at school. She convinced her principal of its uniqueness and was able to get a teacher to sponsor it. She invited her friends and convinced her brother to attend. He teaches the calls while dancing himself since he knows the calls and definitions. She helps explain the more difficult moves to those learning. So far, they are doing

mini squares as they only have two people dancing. In the Spring, the school students were invited to a Rebel Rousers dance, although they did not know all of the moves.

At her home dance, she engages other teens who often come at her suggestion. None of these teens have completed formal square dance lessons but are learning as they go. These two divide them up into squares with experienced dancers and have "trial tips" with Mike calling them. She has also encouraged the parents of these teens to learn to dance and has recruited Rebel Rouser dancers to partner with them.

These two have attended club dances regularly and have attended NORTEX Teen dances. A dancer has complimented these two by saying "they have done an outstanding job of engaging other youth and sharing the wholesome fun of square dancing. She is thoughtful and energetic and both are so impressive and are the kind of youth that give teenagers a better name".



Tommy & Erin Uzee - Star Award They began square dancing in 2023 and quickly became an integral part of their club. They took two sets of lessons and plus lessons. The two of them have become a driving force within their club, NORTEX and the CASUL communities. In spite their busy schedule, they attend numerous dances and generously volunteer their time and talents. Their contributions continue to make a lasting impact on the dancing community.



Kaye Gregory - Star Award She and her husband, Jack, first took lessons with the Roadrunners, in 2015. As with all new dancers, their confidence was low but they stuck with it. They can remember the dance and the caller of the tip when they finally danced without breaking a square down. She produces many flyers for the Promo/Demo dances as she takes crazy ideas and turns them into beautiful flyers. These talents were also recognized by Audrey Mansell, as she got involved in helping with the Promenade. She did a great deal of artwork for the NORTEX History chapters when we updated the old history and added a couple of decades to bring it to current. That work continues yearly as each new NORTEX year begins and the chapter for the previous closes. This led to her being recruited to do the program book for the 75th National Square Dance Convention in Waco. The 75NSDC Chairman

is blown away by her talents and attention to detail. She is from Longview, Texas and was a "Pine Tree Girl", making her feel right at home at the Texas State Convention in Longview this year.



Dani & Becca Woolever - Spark Award These dancers come from a family of square dancers. One learned to dance as a teen while the other one learned as a pre-teen. They used You Tube videos to learn a lot about how to dance and Mike Bramlett taught them formally. They have been to the state dance several times. Their energy is contagious where ever they go. I have seen them making new friends as they dance in other areas. You may notice them videoing the squares they are dancing in. These videos are posted on social media under the name "Chaos in Motion" - take time to look it up.



Noah Austin - NORTEX Teen Scholarship Noah maintains excellent grades, plays sports and works parttime. He took lessons with Tri-City Promenaders in 2024, joined Circle I and works alongside his parents, Tim and Tam. He not only shows up but steps up helping his home club, traveling for club visitations and supporting Teen Dances hosted by NORTEX. He represents the future of our dancing community. Noah is going to college to answer a calling to become a Youth or Children's Pastor at Oklahoma Baptist University in August. We know he will keep the music going in Oklahoma, as he plans to join the local Shawnee Squares Eights group - OBU's brand new campus square dancing club. We are so proud to back his journey.
